Dear Colleague

RE: TOUCHLINE FINES

I have been asked to remind all managers, parents/carers or friends to refrain from making any derogatory comments towards the referee or opposition.

Towards the end of last year, a parent received a fine of £125.00 for his over zealous questioning of a referee at our ground. This fine was then doubled because HRFC are still completing a suspended 2 year sentence for failing to control the behaviour of parent(s) in an incident that occurred over 2 years previously.

As a club, HRFC took the decision to meet half the cost of this fine (£125) because the parent in the incident last year had no knowledge of the fact that as a club, we are under a suspended sentence. However, this is not something we can afford to repeat. Therefore, I am writing to everyone to inform them that any future fine will be met by the individual concerned, in full, effective immediately.
