

## Hamsey Rangers – Managers Meeting, 28<sup>th</sup> November 2010 at 3pm

Apology's: 9(JW) senior(SS) Treasurer (ST)

### 1. Disciplinary Matters

The number of incidents being reported to the FA is unacceptable as is the nature of the incidents, the majority of which have been violent conduct. Players have also been walking off the pitch and refusing to accept the cards issued by the ref. It was re-iterated that the ref is there to perform a job and should be respected by all, if managers disagree with decisions then they need to feed this back after the game in the appropriate manner.

Members who sit on the disciplinary committee are, WPS, JS and AB, the managers were concerned that there was a conflict of interest with AB sitting on the disciplinary committee and also holding the position of Welfare officer as one of the duties of the Welfare Officer is to assist the child as his/hers representative in any disciplinary hearing

**Action: Managers to reinforce the 'code of conduct' to all players. The membership of the disciplinary committee is to be looked at and changed where necessary.**

### 2. Charter Mark

The form is to be submitted by Jan 2011 and we will be having visits before the end of the year. All managers need to ensure they have their child safety and first aid current. Please see Lisa to arrange to go on a course. LC has just done her child safety and found very helpful.

The club now has 2 welfare officers AB and LC

**Action: LC to book first aid for U 14 girls and to investigate Referee courses for a few members who want to become referee's for the club.**

### 3. Fines

ST will be emailing parents where standing orders issued have arisen and/or have bounced.

The number of managers and players fines is excessive. The club has forwarded £600 to the FA and Tandridge league to cover the cost this season most of which has been spent. ST will be chasing managers and players for outstanding fine money. The most common reasons for fines are incomplete match cards and/or late posting of match information on the Ourkidssports website

**Action: Managers must check their cards before handing them over to the opposing manager and ensure the website is updated before 6pm on Sunday evening after games.**

### 4. Pitch Allocation

To preserve our pitches managers to stop training in the goal mouths and ask away teams also to respect this request. Also pitches are carefully allocate based on a number of factors including wear

and tear and frequency of use, therefore managers on the 11 a side pitches must stick to the pitch they have been allocated,

**Action: Managers to play on their allocated pitch (not applicable to mini's)**

5. Training Balls

Is a match ball necessary or does the club purchase better quality training balls, this is up for debate for next season?

6. Club House

Both home and opposition teams have been causing unnecessary mess in the bar and conservatory areas.

**Action: Managers to reinforce respect for the club house, particularly the bar area and conservatory where boots are not to be worn. An updated sign regarding where not to wear football boots in the club will be produced.**

7. Level 2's

Cost of a Level 2 is £350.00. The club, finances permitting, will invest in the higher level training next season; consideration will be given to taking modules of the programme.

**Action: LC to investigate the club delivering the referee's programme which would be open to all managers, coaches and where appropriate players.**

8. Christmas Party is cancelled

MC will holding a party for the seniors and everyone is welcome!!!!!!There will also be a New Years Eve party at the club more details to follow.

9. AOB

Where sponsorship is not available and the team wish to purchase additional kit for players then please email LC with requests. All purchases must be the clubs colours.

**Action: LC to advise WPS cost of tracksuits for the U 10 Hurricanes**

**Action: MC has requested all managers to feedback any requests from players and parents to Hamsey committee regarding the ongoing development of the club. Ideas and suggestions can then be taken forward to the John Fisher committee for consideration**

**Action: CH to get 6 keys cut for the garage and give to MC**

Managers are asked to check that goals are pegged and flags in the ground before matches commence.

All club members are asked to keep the grounds tidy, to date the litter problem has been minimal and we would like to keep it this way
